Pupil Premium

This is additional money given to schools to support certain groups of children:

- ❖ Looked After Children
- ❖ Children who have been eligible for Free School Meals at any point in the last 6 years.

Revision and homework books for Y6 children. **about £500**



Access to emotional and therapeutic support from a counsellor. **about £11,000**



Family Support across school. **about £20,500**



1:1 extra teaching for Y6 (those who may not make expected progress) **about £14,000**



Breakfast club. **about £5,500**



Extra welfare staff to provide structured activities. **about £4,000**



Subsidised trips and visitors. **£8,500**



Raising aspirations (Children's University). **£4,000**



Social interaction support for identified Y6 children. **£1,500**

...and the impact?

- In the Foundation Stage pupil premium children outperformed the non-pupil premium children in PE and expressive arts.
- At the end of KS1 our pupil premium children had worked so well the gap disappeared altogether in reading and maths.
- At the end of KS2 attainment has improved in maths for pupil premium children.
- There are more pupil premium children accessing and enjoying extra-curricular activities and trips to enrich the curriculum.
- Attendance in school is improved both for all children and for the pupil premium children.
- Social and Emotional behaviour development of pupils due to the extra clubs at lunchtimes.
- Pupils start the day by socialising positively with peers and eating a healthy breakfast enabling greater concentration.
- Pupil premium pupils accessed free trips during the year which provided experiences for social, moral and cultural understanding.
