The Parents' Evenings planned for 23rd and 24th March have all been cancelled. These will be re-arranged as soon as it is possible.

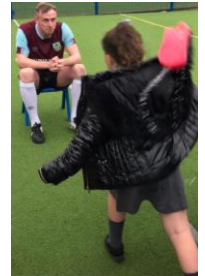
After School Clubs
